## **HRVC Risk Management Policy**

The purpose of the risk management policy is to ensure the safety of participants and Club Members and promote a safe and positive sporting environment for the participants to enjoy the sport of volleyball.

## Halton Region Volleyball Club:

- 1. aims to use best practices in risk management to support and enhance our activities in all areas of our club.
- 2. will ensure risk management is an integral part of all our decision-making processes.
- 3. will identify and take advantage of opportunities as well as minimizing adverse effects to protect the Club and its members.
- 4. will train our people to implement risk management effectively in all areas of our club.
- 5. will strive to continually improve our risk management practices through a thorough review process.

## **Our Process**

- 1. Halton Region Volleyball Club will have a standing member on the Board of Directors serve as Halton Region Volleyball Club's Risk Management Officer.
- 2. The Risk Management Officer will be accountable for the implementation of the risk management policy and will be responsible for the management of risks in the Club.
- 3. All key personnel are required to manage associated risks within their own areas of the club.
- 4. The Risk Management Officer will develop and create a common risk management approach across areas of our club by:
  - a. Communicating with all members of the club, associated risks and solutions.
  - b. Sharing information with members and personnel on updates with Risk Management development.
  - c. Reporting on the progress to the board and members on the risk management program
